USE OF VTS TRUCKS IN THE TRANSFER OF CARGOES TO ATI-ICD CALAMBA, SUBIC AND CLARK SPECIAL ECONOMIC ZONES

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. To enhance the Bureau's capability to effectively monitor transfer of cargoes to Subic and Clark SEZs
- 2. To establish an efficient system of audit and accounting of cargo transfers
- 3. To keep the Bureau at par with best international practices

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COVERAGE

In the interim, this order shall apply to transfers of cargoes from POM/MICP to ATI-ICD Calamba, Subic and Clark SEZs.

III

ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS

- iii.1 Only trucks with VTS capability shall be authorized to haul cargoes from POM/MICP to ATI-ICD Calamba, Subic, and Clark SEZs
- iii.2 VTS providers shall be accredited by the Bureau upon satisfying the minimum parameters set forth in CMO 16-97. SBMA and CDC shall be regularly furnished a list of accredited providers.
- iii.3 The use of the VTS technology shall replace underguarding of cargo transfers
