

**[ MTC MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 02, S. 1996,  
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**REVISED CURRICULA AND ACCREDITATION CHECKLIST FOR  
SHIPS RESTRICTED RADIOTELEPHONE, SATELLITE  
COMMUNICATION AND GLOBAL MARITIME DISTRESS AND  
SAFETY SYSTEM COURSES**

1. The Maritime Training Council - Technical Working Group has approved the revision of the curricula and accreditation instruments for SRROC, INMARSAT and GMDSS upon the recommendation of the TWG Sub-Committee on Communication Courses that conducted proper consultation with instructors from different training centers.

2. The syllabi for these courses, as formulated and approved in 1989, shall be followed and presented into three modules, to wit:

.1 Module I — Satellite Communication (INMARSAT) Course - 40 hours;

.2 Module II — Ships Restricted Radiotelephone Operator Course - 40 hours; and

.3 Module III — Global Maritime Distress and Safety System - 40 hours.

3. In addition to the existing syllabus for the Ships Restricted Radiotelephone Operator Course (SRROC), the signalling by Morse Code based from the Module 12, Communication, IMO Model Course 7.03, for one hour and another three hours for Search and Rescue (SAR) exercises are also adopted. The training/learning objectives of Signalling by Morse Code are as follows:

.1 Identify Morse Code for the alphabet.

.2 Send and receive Morse signals by flashing light at a rate of 15 characters per minute.

.3 List the parts of a signal made by flashing as "the call".

.4 Correct use of the "erase" signal when signalling or receiving.

.5 Explain the use of the waiting signal AS.

.6 Correct use of "repetition" signals, AA, AB, WA, WB.

.7 Correct use of "repeat" signal.

.8 Demonstrate the use of the procedure signals C, N, and RQ and state that they cannot be used with single-letter, signals.
