II

ORGANIZATION

There is hereby created a BOC-SGS Appeals Committee II under the Office of the Commissioner which shall be composed of the following:

- 1. Deputy Commissioner for Internal Administration Group Chairman
- 2. Director. Legal Service, or his representative Member
- 3. Deputy Collector for Assessment, POM, or his representative Member
- 4. Deputy Collector for Assessment, MICP, or his representative Member
- 5. Deputy Collector for Assessment, NAIA, or his representative Member
- 6. Representative of the PCCI Member
- 7. Representative of the SGS Member
- 8. Representative of the Tariff Commission Member
- 9. Representative of the Bureau of Import Services Member

III

JURISDICTION

The Committee shall have jurisdiction relative to questions/disputes:

1. Arising from SGS classification as reported in the SGS-CRF.
