PROHIBITING THE COLLECTION OF CONTRIBUTIONS FROM STUDENTS OF PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

- 1. This Office has received complaints from parents and students regarding the collection of contributions including those that are voluntary but authorized by law and this Office. In spite of the orders issued by this Office that such collections are not requirements for enrolment, many school officials and teachers still require students to pay such contributions at the enrolment period. This is a violation of the concept of free elementary education.
- 2. Henceforth, no contributions whatsoever will be collected from the public elementary students during the enrolment period.
- 3. Authorized contributions, including membership fees to Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts of the Philippines, the National Red Cross, and Anti-TB educational and fund campaign, shall be solicited on a voluntary basis not during the period of enrolment but only during their respective campaign period as follows:

d. Anti-TB Educational and FundJanuary- Campaign December		P1.00/ student

- 4. Membership fee to the PTA/PTCA shall be fixed at not more than twenty pesos (P20.00) per parent-member. Likewise, the PTA/PTCA membership fee and all other contributions shall be collected not earlier than three (3) months after the enrolment period.
