## [ PPA ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 02-92, April 13, 1992 ]

## RECLASSIFICATION OF VARIOUS PRODUCTS AS NON-DANGEROUS CARGOES

In order to further rationalize the imposition of surcharges on dangerous cargo under PPA Administrative Order No. 02-89, the following cargoes are hereby delisted from those chargeable with dangerous cargo tariff surcharge as contained in PPA Admin. Order No. 62-89 provided such cargoes are transported in container vans.

- 1. Hydraulic brake fluid
- 2. Charcoal (activated or non-activated)
- Copper
- 4. Cosmetics
- 5. Cotton Waste
- 6. Safety Fuse
- 7. Hemp
- 8. Medicines
- 9. Alcoholic Beverages, such as Tanduay Rhum, Añejo Rhum, Club Valentino Rhum and others.

This modifies PPA Administrative Order No. 02-89 which is entitled "Cargo Handling Rate for Dangerous/Obnoxious Cargoes".

This Order shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
