[BAI ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 6, April 02, 1992]

AMENDING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 29 ENTITLED "REGISTRATION AND BRANDING OF LARGE ANIMALS IMPORTED TO THE PHILIPPINES"

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Commonwealth Act No. 379 Section 3 on branding of imported horses on the right side of the neck under Administrative Order No. 29 series of 1968 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The Director of Animal Industry or his duly authorized representative, at the time of the registration or as soon thereafter as practicable, shall brand or cause the branding of cattle presented for registration with three zeros (000) using iron brand in the right side of the THIGH in case of horses."

2. This Order shall take effect fifteen (15) days after the last day of its publication in a newspaper or general circulation and three (3) copies thereof filed before the U.P. Law Center.
