Issuance of Student Driver's Permit

While we simplified the issuance of Student Driver's Permit (SDP) to the barest minimum of requirements and procedures for the convenience of the public, it is sad to note that there had the convenience of the public, it is sad note that there had been cases and/or attempts to sabotage the system that is in place.

In view of this, therefore, the following are hereby promulgated for the observance of all concerned:

1

No Renewal of Student Driver's Permit

Once the Permit expires one year after its issuance, its holder must apply for a new one where the new apprenticeship period will be reckoned from. It shall be understood, therefore, that the conversion of the Permit into a license must be within its one (1) year validity.

Issuance of Duplicate Student Driver's Permit

In case of a lost Permit, a duplicate could be issued in its stead but shall be valid only up to the remaining portion of the validity of the original Permit. If the lost Permit has already expired, the student driver should apply for a new Permit wherefrom the new apprenticeship period shall be reckoned.
