

**[ PROCLAMATION NO. 1591, August 20, 2008 ]**

**DECLARING SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 2008, AS SPECIAL  
(NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MALVAR,  
PROVINCE OF BATANGAS**

**WHEREAS**, Saturday, September 27, 2008, marks the 143rd birth anniversary of General Miguel Malvar, the last general of the Philippine Revolution to surrender to the Americans;
