# [ Act No. 2786, December 21, 1918 ]

### AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Legislature assembled and by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated, out of any funds in the Insular Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for public works as mentioned hereunder, and for other purposes of the Insular Government.

NON-CHRISTIAN AND SPECIAL PROVINCES, INCLUDING BATANES, MINDORO, PALAWAN, AND ALL SPECIAL PROVINCES THAT MAY BE ORGANIZED DURING THE YEAR 1919.

(a)	For the construction, improvement, and extension of telephone lines	P50,000.00
(b)	For aid to local governments in the construction of a simple type of sanitary public market	25,000.00
(c)	For aid, especially in furnishing materials not produced in the locality, in the construction and improvement of public buildings, and for other purposes	30,000.00
