[Act No. 2327, February 19, 1914]

AN ACT TO AMEND ACT NUMBERED NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY-TWO, AS AMENDED BY ACT NUMBERED TWO THOUSAND AND NINETY-ONE, BY PROVIDING THAT THE SALARY OF THE SECRETARY-TREASURER OF THE PROVINCE OF BATANES SHALL BE TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED PESOS PER ANNUM.

By authority of the United States, be it enacted by the Philippine Legislature, that:

SECTION 1. Subsection (6) of section two of Act Numbered Nineteen hundred and fifty-two, as amended by Act Numbered Two thousand and ninety-one, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"(b) There shall be a secretary-treasurer of the province, who shall reside and have his office at the capital thereof. He shall receive a salary not to exceed two thousand four hundred pesos per annum. He shall exercise the powers and perform the duties of provincial secretary and provincial treasurer as defined in Act Numbered Thirteen hundred and ninety-six, entitled 'The Special Provincial Government Act,' as amended, and in Act Numbered Thirteen hundred and ninety-seven, entitled 'The Township Government Act,' as amended."
