[Act No. 2406, July 14, 1914]

AN ACT APPROPRIATING THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND PESOS TO AID THE NON-CHRISTIAN PEOPLE OF THE MOUNTAIN PROVINCE AND TO PROMOTE THEIR UNION WITH THE CHRISTIAN PEOPLE OF THE PHILIPPINES.

By authority of the United States, be it enacted bit the Philippine Commission, that:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated, out of any funds in the Insular Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of thirty-five thousand pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the employment of doctors and nurses; the establishment and support of dispensaries; and the establishment and support of schools in the Mountain Province and its subprovinces; and for other purposes, as follows:
