

[Act No. 2288, October 31, 1913]

AN ACT APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND PESOS PHILIPPINE CURRENCY FOR PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

By authority of the United States, be it enacted by the Philippine Legislature, that:

SECTION 1. The sum of one hundred and seventy-five thousand pesos Philippine currency is hereby appropriated, out of any funds in the Insular Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the support of public schools in the provinces subject to the control of the Philippine Legislature.

SEC. 2. Any sum left over from the funds appropriated by this Act at the close of the present fiscal year shall be turned into the Insular Treasury and accrue to the general fund.

Enacted, October 31, 1913.
