

[ Act No. 1939, May 20, 1909 ]

**AN ACT ADDING A PROVISIO TO SUBSECTION (B) OF SECTION TWELVE OF ACT NUMBERED SEVENTEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND IN CERTAIN RESPECTS ACT NUMBERED EIGHTY-TWO, KNOWN AS THE 'MUNICIPAL CODE' " BY PROVIDING TLIAT THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL MAY, IN ITS DISCRETION, EXTEND THE TIME FOR THE PAYMENT, WITHOUT PENALTY, OF CERTAIN LICENSE TAXES.**

*By authority of the United States, be it enacted by the Philippine Legislature, that:*

SECTION 1. The following words are hereby added at the end of subsection (b) of section twelve of Act Numbered Seventeen hundred and ninety-one:

*"Provided, further, That the ten days extension of time for such payment, without penalty, may be extended ten days further, in the discretion of each municipal council, for the following reasons: Bad condition of roads, breaking of bridges, great "freshets, and other analogous circumstances."*

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect on its passage.
