[Act No. 1370, July 07, 1905]

AN ACT AMENDING SECTION ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-NINE OF ACT NUMBERED ELEVEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE, ENTITLED "THE INTERNAL REVENUE LAW OF NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FOUR," BY STRIKING OUT THEREFROM THE WORDS "FOR DOMESTIC CONSUMPTION."

By authority of the United States, be it enacted by the Philippine Commission, that:

SECTION 1. Section one hundred and thirty-nine of Act Numbered Eleven hundred and eighty-nine, entitled "The Internal Revenue Law of Nineteen hundred and four," is hereby amended by striking out therefrom the words "for domestic consumption."

SEC. 2. The public good requiring the speedy enactment of this bill, the passage of the same is hereby expedited in accordance with section two of "An Act prescribing the order of procedure by the Commission in the enactment of laws," passed September twenty-sixth, nineteen hundred.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect on its passage.
