

[Act No. 1385, September 01, 1905]

AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE LAND TAX IN THE MUNICIPALITIES OF ESCALANTE, SAGAY, AND CAUAYAN, PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL NEGROS, FOR THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FIVE UNTIL DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FIVE.

By authority of the United States, be it enacted by the Philippine Commission, that:

SECTION 1. The period for the payment, without penalty, of the land tax for the year nineteen hundred and five in the municipalities of Escalante, Sagay, and Cauayan, Province of Occidental Negros, is hereby extended to December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and five. All penalties heretofore collected for the nonpayment of the land tax in such municipalities for the year nineteen hundred and five are hereby remitted, and the treasurer of the Province of Occidental Negros is authorized and directed to allow a rebate of the amount of such penalty to the taxpayer upon whom the penalty was assessed upon payment of his land, tax for the year next; ensuing.

SEC. 2. The public good requiring the speedy enactment of this bill, the passage of the same is hereby expedited in accordance with section two of "An Act prescribing the order of procedure by the Commission in the enactment of laws," passed September twenty-sixth, nineteen hundred.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect on its passage.
