

[Act No. 1236, September 22, 1904]

AN ACT AMENDING ACT NUMBERED FOUR HUNDRED AND NINETEEN, EXTENDING THE PROVISIONS OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ACT AND ITS AMENDMENTS TO THE PROVINCE OF SAMAR, BY INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE PROVINCIAL SUPERVISOR TO ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS PER ANNUM.

By authority of the United States, be it enacted by the Philippine Commission, that:

SECTION 1. Act Numbered Four hundred and nineteen, extending the provisions of the Provincial Government Act and its amendments to the Province of Samar, is hereby amended by striking out the words "for the provincial supervisor, one thousand four hundred dollars," in section two of said Act, and inserting in lieu thereof "for the provincial supervisor, one thousand eight hundred dollars."

SEC. 2. The public good requiring the speedy enactment of this bill, the passage of the same is hereby expedited in accordance with section two of "An Act prescribing the order of procedure by the Commission in the enactment of laws," passed September twenty-sixth, nineteen hundred.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect on its passage.
