

[Act No. 332, January 21, 1902]

AN ACT DECLARING THE BARRIOS OF MAPANDAN, APAYA, LUYAN, BALOLIN, AMANWAWAK, AND NILIMBOT, NOW A PART OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MAGALDAN, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN, TO BE A NEW MUNICIPALITY UNDER THE NAME OF MAPANDAN.

By authority of the President of the United States, be it enacted by the United States Philippine Commission, that:

SECTION 1. The barrios of Mapandan, Apaya, Luyan, Balolin, Amanwawak, and Nilimbot, now forming a part of the municipality of Magaldan, Province of Pangasinan, are hereby separated from said municipality to form a new municipality under the name of Mapandan. The provincial supervisor of Pangasinan shall survey at once the new municipality in order to establish in a definite and precise manner the boundary lines which separate it from the adjacent, municipalities, and to report to the provincial board the Municipal election, results of such survey. After the provincial supervisor has established the boundary lines of the municipality and has reported to the provincial board, a municipal election shall be held in such municipality in accordance with the provisions of articles ninety-one, ninety-two, ninety-three, and ninety-four of the Municipal Code.

SEC. 2. The public good requiring the speedy enactment of this bill, the passage of the same is hereby expedited in accordance with section two of "An Act prescribing the order of procedure by the Commission in the enactment of laws," passed September twenty-sixth, nineteen hundred.

Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect on its passage.
