

[BATAS PAMBANSA BLG. 586, June 24, 1983]

**AN ACT CONVERTING THE DIBULUAN BARANGAY HIGH SCHOOL
IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF JONES, PROVINCE OF ISABELA, INTO
A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS THE DIBULUAN
NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND AUTHORIZING THE
APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS THEREFOR.**

Be it enacted by the Batasang Pambansa in session assembled:

SECTION 1. The Dibuluan Barangay High School in the Municipality of Jones, Province of Isabela, is converted into a national high school to be known as the Dibuluan High School.

SEC. 2. The amount of one hundred thousand pesos for the operation of the school shall be funded out of the appropriations authorized by Batas Pambansa Blg. 230 for the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports intended for new national high schools and an additional amount corresponding to fifty percent of its share in the budgetary aid actually paid to it before such conversion shall be released from its operation from the national assistance fund for local schools. Thereafter, such sum as may be necessary for its operation and maintenance shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
