

[GENERAL ORDER NO. 2-C, October 27, 1972]

AUTHORIZING THE ARREST AND DETENTION OF ANY PERSON OR PERSONS ENGAGED IN FISHING BY DYNAMITE, EXPLOSIVE OR OTHER TOXIC SUBSTANCES AND/OR ANY PERSONS IN POSSESSION OF, SELLING OR DISTRIBUTING FISH OR OTHER AQUATIC ANIMALS STUPEFIED, DISABLED AND KILLED BY MEANS OF DYNAMITE, EXPLOSIVE AND OTHER TOXIC SUBSTANCES.

General Order Ho. 2, dates September 22, 1972, amended by General No. 2-A; is hereby further amended to include the following provision:

"21. Any person or persons known to be, or caught engaged in fishing by dynamite, other explosives or obnoxious or poisonous substances, and any person or persons in possession of, or, engaged in the sale or distribution of fish or other aquatic animals stupified, disabled or killed by means of dynamite, explosives or other obnoxious or poisonous substances,"
