[LETTER OF INSTRUCTIONS No. 1471, July 09, 1985]

TO: The Presidential Assistant on Economic & Development Affairs, The Minister, Ministry of Trade and Industry, The Chairman, Board of Investments, The Commissioner, Bureau of Customs, The President, Philippine Export Council, The Commissioner, Bureau of Internal Revenue, The Director, Export Department, Central Bank of the Philippines, The Administrator, Philippine Port Authority, The Administrator, National Cottage Industries Development, Authority

WHEREAS, under LOI No. 788 dated December 23, 1978, the Presidential Assistant on Economic and Development Affairs was designated Presidential Action Officer on Trade Facilitation in order to direct and oversee the implementation and reevaluatiou oi' the simplified system of export procedures under Presidential Decree No. 930;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned designation may now be terminated since the objective therefor has already been achieved.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, do hereby terminate the designation of the Presidential Assistant on Economic and Development Affairs as Presidential Action Officer on Trade Facilitation effective immediately. The corresponding appropriations of his office under the said designation are hereby reallocated to the Presidential Regional Monitoring Officers.
