CHIEFDOM TREASURIES.

An Ordinance to provide for the establishment constitution and management of Chieftdom Treasuries and treasuries for groups of chieftdoms, and for purposes connected therewith.

[1ST JANUARY, 1938.]

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Chieftdom Treasuries Ordinance. It shall apply to the Protectorate and shall be read and construed as one with the Protectorate Ordinance, or any Ordinance substituted therefor.

2. All chieftdom estimates and group chieftdom estimates of revenue and expenditure shall be submitted to the Governor for approval.

3. (1) It shall be lawful for the Minister to make rules for all or any of the following purposes—

(a) the keeping of accounts of chieftdom and group chieftdom revenues and expenditure and of accounts relating to chieftdom and group chieftdom treasuries;

(b) the making and keeping of inventories and records of chieftdom and group chieftdom property;

(c) the form and manner in which the accounts and estimates of revenue and expenditure of chieftdoms and groups of chieftdoms shall be kept and prepared;

(d) the submission of copies of accounts and estimates to a District Commissioner or any other public officer;
