Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions (Expatriate Officers) Act.

Interpretation

2. In this Act —

“Agreement” means the Public Officers' Pension (Singapore) Agreement 1976 between the Government of the Republic of Singapore and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland signed at Singapore on 26th March 1976;

“law relating to pensions” means —

(a) the Retirement from the Public Service (Compensation) Ordinance 1956;

(b) the Pensions Act [Cap. 225] and the regulations made thereunder; and

(c) the Widows' and Orphans' Pension Act [Cap. 350];
