ACTIVE MOBILITY (SHARED PATHS) ORDER 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Active Mobility Act 2017, the Land Transport Authority of Singapore makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Active Mobility (Shared Paths) Order 2018 and comes into operation on 1 May 2018.

Definitions

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires —

“HDB” means the Housing and Development Board established by the Housing and Development Act (Cap. 129);

“HDB land” means land that is vested in or belonging to the Housing and Development Board and —

(a) under the control and management of the Housing and Development Board; or

(b) under the control and management of a Town Council;

“MRT” means a rapid transit system constructed under the Rapid Transit Systems Act (Cap. 263A) described as a Mass Rapid Transit system;

“MRT station” means a railway station that is part of a rapid transit system constructed under the Rapid Transit Systems Act;

“National Parks Board” means the National Parks Board established by the repealed National Parks Act (Cap. 198A, 1991 Ed.) in force before 1 July 1996 and continued by section 3 of the National Parks Board Act (Cap. 198A).

Shared paths

3.—(1) A path on State land that —

(a) is surfaced with bituminous surfacing material, asphalt, concrete or pavers;

(aa) if the path abuts on a footpath, is either —

(i) demarcated with a red or yellow line (whether continuous or broken) of 100 millimetres in width; or

(ii) red, blue, green or yellow in colour, or coated with a dark grey fibre reinforced polymer cement coating;

(b) is usually at least 2 metres but not more than 4 metres in width; and

(c) is specified or described in the First Schedule,

is each declared to be a shared path for the purposes of the Act.

(2) A path on HDB land that —

(a) is surfaced with bituminous surfacing material, asphalt, concrete or pavers;

- (aa) if the path abuts on a footpath, is either —
- (i) demarcated with a red or yellow line (whether continuous or broken) of 100 millimetres in width; or
 - (ii) red, blue, green or yellow in colour, or coated with a dark grey fibre reinforced polymer cement coating;

(b) is usually at least one metre but not more than 4 metres in width; and

(c) is specified or described in the Second Schedule,

is each declared to be a shared path for the purposes of the Act.

(3) A path on land vested in or under the control or management of the National Parks Board that —

(a) is surfaced with bituminous surfacing material, asphalt, concrete or pavers;

(aa) if the path abuts on a footpath, is demarcated with a red or yellow line (whether continuous or broken) of 100 millimetres in width;

(b) is usually at least 2.5 metres but not more than 6 metres in width; and

(c) is specified or described in the Third Schedule,

is each declared to be a shared path for the purposes of the Act.

3. A path (approximately 0.47 kilometre in length) starting at Ang Mo Kio Avenue 8, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 3 and ending at Ang Mo Kio Avenue 6.

4. A path (approximately 0.13 kilometre in length) starting at Ang Mo Kio Avenue 6, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 3 and ending at Ang Mo Kio Street 22.
5. A path (approximately 0.34 kilometre in length) starting at Ang Mo Kio Street 22, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 3 and ending at Ang Mo Kio Street 23.
6. A path (approximately 0.74 kilometre in length) starting at Ang Mo Kio Street 23, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 3 and ending at Ang Mo Kio Avenue 1.
7. A path (approximately 0.13 kilometre in length) starting at Ang Mo Kio Avenue 3, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 1 and ending at Ang Mo Kio Street 22.
8. A path (approximately 0.71 kilometre in length) starting at Ang Mo Kio Street 22, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 1 and ending at Ang Mo Kio Avenue 6.
9. A path (approximately 0.65 kilometre in length) starting at Ang Mo Kio Avenue 6, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 1 and ending at Ang Mo Kio Street 32.
10. A path (approximately 0.47 kilometre in length) starting at Ang Mo Kio Street 32, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 1 and ending at Ang Mo Kio Avenue 8.
11. A path (approximately 0.06 kilometre in length) starting at Ang Mo Kio Avenue 1, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10 and ending at the vehicular access to Pathlight School.

12. A path (approximately 0.14 kilometre in length) starting at the vehicular access to Pathlight School, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10 and ending at the vehicular access to Townsville Primary School.

13. A path (approximately 0.09 kilometre in length) starting at the vehicular access to Townsville Primary School, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10 and ending at the access leading to the carpark of Block 401 Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10.

14. A path (approximately 0.26 kilometre in length) starting at the access leading to the carpark of Block 401 Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10 and ending at the carpark access near Block 409 Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10.

15. A path (approximately 0.09 kilometre in length) starting at the access leading to the carpark of Block 411 Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10 and ending at the carpark access near Block 412 Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10.

16. A path (approximately 0.12 kilometre in length) starting at the access leading to the carpark of Block 412 Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10 and ending at Ang Mo Kio Street 41.

17. A path (approximately 0.06 kilometre in length) starting at Ang Mo Kio Avenue 8, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 1 and ending at Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10.

18. A path (approximately 0.14 kilometre in length) starting at bus stop number 54199 near Block 163 Ang Mo Kio Avenue 4, running along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 4 and ending at Mayflower Avenue.
