Both are circumscribed by the words “SINGAPORE THIRD ALMANAC COIN SERIES”.</p> <p>Each of the 12 coins surrounding the centre coin depicts an animal of the design featured in the third Chinese Almanac Coin Series, together with the year of issue for that animal, both in Arabic numerals and in Chinese characters. The denomination “\$2” is below each design.</p>
