The Singapore Coat of Arms is engraved in the centre of the coin with the year-date “2019” below it. 3. The word “SINGAPORE” appears once in each of the 4 official languages and is engraved on the coin around the Singapore Coat of Arms. 	
Design of Reverse	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The background of the \$2 silver proof-like colour coin and the \$2 nickel-plated zinc proof-like coin is shiny silver. 2. The \$2 silver proof-like colour coin and the \$2 nickel-plated zinc proof-like coin share a common design which features — <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) a boar engraved in the centre of the foreground; (b) plants engraved in the left and right of the middle ground; (c) stones engraved in the foreground and left and right of the middle ground, with stones on the left of the middle ground partially covered by the boar’s right hind leg; (d) a kelong engraved in the right of the background, with the stilts of the kelong partially covered by the boar’s head; (e) the entrance structure of Pulau Ubin and a bumboat on water engraved in the left of the background, with the railings of the entrance structure partially covered by feature (a); and (f) the respective denomination in figures engraved and placed at 12 o’clock, above the boar. 3. The weight in troy oz and fineness of the coin are engraved above the denomination of the \$2 silver proof-like colour coin. 4. The boar featured in the \$2 silver proof-like colour coin is in colour.

The Singapore Coat of Arms is engraved in the centre of the coin with the year-date “2019” below it. 4. The word “SINGAPORE” appears once in each of the 4 official languages and is engraved on the coin around the Singapore Coat of Arms. 5. The mintmark is engraved on the coin around the Singapore Coat of Arms at 5 o’clock for the \$5 silver proof coin and the \$5 silver proof colour coin.
Design of Reverse	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The background of the \$5 silver proof coin and the \$5 silver proof colour coin is shiny silver. 2. The background of the \$5 gold brilliant uncirculated coin is shiny gold. 3. The \$5 silver proof coin and the \$5 silver proof colour coin share a common design which features — <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) a boar engraved in the centre of the foreground; (b) plants engraved in the left and right of the middle ground; (c) stones engraved in the foreground and left and right of the middle ground, with stones on the left of the middle ground partially covered by the boar’s right hind leg; (d) a kelong engraved in the right of the background, with the stilts of the kelong partially covered by the boar’s head; (e) the entrance structure of Pulau Ubin and a bumboat on water engraved in the left of the background, with the railings of the entrance structure partially covered by feature (a); (f) the respective denomination in figures engraved and placed at 12 o’clock, above the boar; and (g) the weight in troy oz and fineness of the coin, engraved above the denomination of the coin. 4. The boar featured in the \$5 silver proof colour coin is in colour. 5. The \$5 gold brilliant uncirculated coin features — <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) a boar engraved in the centre; (b) the denomination “\$5” engraved and placed at 6 o’clock, below the boar; and (c) the weight in grams and fineness of the coin, engraved and placed at 12 o’clock, above the boar.
