The position of the mintmark is at 5 o’ clock.	The main feature of the coin is the portrait of the royal couple in the centre, with the words “DYTM PADUKA SERI PENGIRAN MUDA MAHKOTA PENGIRAN MUDA HAJI AL-MUHTADEE BILLAH AND DAYANGKU SARAH BINTI PENGIRAN SALLEH AB RAHAMAN” below it. At the circumference, the words “IN COMMEMORATION OF THE ROYAL WEDDING OF THE CROWN PRINCE OF BRUNEI DARUSSALAM” are above the portrait, and the wedding date “9 SEPTEMBER 2004” at the bottom.
