This area is anchored by the 130-hectare Sungei Buloh Wetland Reserve and the tranquil Kranji Reservoir. The main feature of this coin is the Sungei Buloh Wetland Reserve, an idyllic nature reserve where visitors can observe

							<p>migratory birds and view the vast species of native mangrove flora without getting their feet wet. Depicted on the right is the 18-metre tall Bird Observatory Tower that offers panoramic views of the Reserve and the surrounding areas. At the left bottom are the distinct tidal gates of Kranji Reservoir used to regulate the level of water in the reservoir. The coin also features some common animals found in the area to capture its fauna. The denomination is at the top centre of the coin.</p>
