DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR OFFICERS (OATHS AND FEES) ACT (CHAPTER 82)

DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR OFFICERS (FEES) ORDER 2012

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Diplomatic and Consular Officers (Oaths and Fees) Act, the Minister for Foreign Affairs hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Diplomatic and Consular Officers (Fees) Order 2012 and shall come into operation on 14th February 2012.

Fees

2.—(1) The fees specified in the Schedule shall be leviable in respect of the matters or things done in the execution of his office by a diplomatic or consular officer.

(2) Such fees shall be in the equivalent local currency of the country to which such officer is accredited.

Remission of fees

3. The Minister may, in his discretion, remit wholly or in part, and either generally or in any particular case or class of cases, any fee specified in the Schedule.

Revocation

4. The Diplomatic and Consular Officers (Fees) Order (O 1) is revoked.

BIRTHS AND DEATHS

Application for a certified extract from —

the register of births in Form L set out in the Schedule to the Registration of Births and Deaths Rules (Cap. 267, R 1) \$40

the register of deaths in Form M set out in the Schedule to the Registration of Births and Deaths Rules \$40

Application for a certified extract, under paragraph (1), where the extract is required for Government purposes No charge

For a search in any register —

where the applicant produces evidence of the number of the entry No charge

where the search involves a scrutiny of the register covering a specified period, for every month or part thereof covered by the period \$40

For any search made on behalf of the Government No charge

Application for recording the name of any child whose birth has been registered without a name \$60

For the correction of errors under section 24(3) of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act (Cap. 267), for every word or figure corrected \$60 subject to a maximum of \$180

Application for altering the name of a child \$33

For a certificate of registration of birth \$18
