The Minister for Home Affairs has declared the games, methods, devices, schemes or competitions set out in the Schedule to be lotteries for the purposes of the Act.

THE SCHEDULE

- (a) The "100 characters", "1,000 characters" or "10,000 characters" game also known as the "100 numbers", "1,000 numbers" or "10,000 numbers" game also known as the "two-digit", "three-digit" or "four-digit" game also known as the "two-number", "three-number" or "four-number" game also known as the *Tikam Ekor* game or any variation thereof.
- (b) The Chap Ji Kee or "12 characters" game.
- (c) The Wha Whey or Wah Weh.
