PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS ACT (CHAPTER 218)

PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS (EXCLUDED ELECTION ADVERTISING) REGULATIONS 2011

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 78B(2)(f) and 102 of the Parliamentary Elections Act, the Prime Minister hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Parliamentary Elections (Excluded Election Advertising) Regulations 2011 and shall come into operation on 14th March 2011.

Definition

2. In these Regulations, “party political broadcast” means a broadcast of a speech —

- (a) made by one or more candidates of a political party whose candidates are nominated for election at a general election or an election in an electoral division, as the case may be; and
