Citation

1. These Rules may be cited as the Petroleum (Transport by Land — Fees) Rules.

Fees

- 2. The annual fee payable for a licence issued under the Act or any rules made thereunder in respect of a vehicle used for transporting petroleum or dangerous petroleum shall be as follows:
- (a) for lorries transporting petroleum in cans or drums in a quantity not less than 180 litres but not exceeding 4,500 litres, or dangerous petroleum in cans or drums in a quantity not exceeding 4,500 litres \$50.00
- (b) for bulk tankers transporting petroleum in bulk in a quantity not less than 180 litres but not exceeding 5,400 litres, or dangerous petroleum in bulk in a \$50.00
