PRIVATE INVESTIGATION AND SECURITY AGENCIES (EXEMPTION) REGULATIONS 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 27(g) of the Private Investigation and Security Agencies Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Private Investigation and Security Agencies (Exemption) Regulations 2004 and shall come into operation on 15th June 2004.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts, from section 5 of the Act, any person who carries on the business of a private investigator exclusively by one or more of the following acts:

- (a) searching for information, by whatever means, on the World Wide Web through the Internet;
- (b) obtaining information or securing evidence from any Internet website which —
