In exercise of the powers conferred by section 48(1) of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Rules:

### **Citation and commencement**

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (Competency Tests) Rules 2021 and come into operation on 30 June 2021.

### **Definitions**

2. In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires —

“pass”, for a prescribed test of competence, means to sit for and successfully complete the prescribed test of competence;

“sit”, for a prescribed test of competence, means to attend and take the prescribed test of competence.

### **Road-only PAB**

3. For the purposes of section 47G(1) of the Act, a road-only PAB is a power-assisted bicycle that —

- (a) complies with the specified requirements mentioned in rule 3(2) of the Road Traffic (Power-Assisted Bicycles — Approval) Rules 2004 (G.N. No. S 768/2004) and the keeping or use of which on a road is not unlawful under those Rules; and
- (b) has either an unladen weight exceeding 20 kilograms or a width exceeding 70 centimetres.

### **Tests of competence**

4.—(1) For the purposes of section 47H of the Act, the prescribed test of competence for a road-only PAB consists of a PAB Theory Test covering subject matters described in the Schedule relating to safe driving or riding practices and law on public paths and roads.

(2) Every prescribed test of competence may be administered to an individual sitting for the test in one of the following ways, at the option of the individual:

- (a) in person using pen, paper or other writing materials;
- (b) remotely or in person through oral questions and answers;
- (c) remotely and online.
