ROAD TRAFFIC (REBATE ON LICENCE FEE FOR MOTOR VEHICLES) RULES 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 11(4A) and 140 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Communications hereby makes the following Rules:

Citation, commencement and application

1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Road Traffic (Rebate on Licence Fee for Motor Vehicles) Rules 1998 and shall come into operation on 17th July 1998.

(2) These Rules shall not apply to any motor vehicle —

- (a) in respect of which a permit has been issued under section 25 of the Act;
- (b) which has been approved by the Registrar as a vintage vehicle pursuant to rule 5(2) of the Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Registration and Licensing) Rules (R 5); or
- (c) which is a trailer.
