An Act to amend the Regulation of Imports and Exports Act (Chapter 272A of the 1996 Revised Edition) and to make consequential amendments to the Customs Act (Chapter 70 of the 2004 Revised Edition).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Regulation of Imports and Exports (Amendment) Act 2014 and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by notification in the *Gazette*, appoint.

Amendment of section 3

2. Section 3(2) of the Regulation of Imports and Exports Act (referred to in this Act as the principal Act) is amended by deleting the words “any other person who has made” in paragraph (k) and substituting the words “any person making”.

Amendment of section 31

3. Section 31 of the principal Act is amended —

(a) by deleting paragraphs (iv) and (v) of subsection (1) and substituting the following paragraphs:

“(iv) a prosecution of such offence under such written law (other than this Act) as may be prescribed;

(v) enabling a public agency to enforce such provision of written law (other than this Act) as may be prescribed;

(vi) enabling a public agency to investigate a suspected offence under such provision of written law (other than this Act) as may be prescribed;

(vii) subject to subsection (1A), enabling a public agency to discharge its function, duty or power of collecting, compiling and analysing the particulars or information, and —

(A) providing its collection, compilation or analysis to another public agency for policy formulation or review by that other public agency; or

(B) publishing its collection, compilation or analysis in such form as will not identify,
