STATISTICS (AMENDMENT) ACT 2004

Date of Commencement: 1st July 2004

An Act to amend the Statistics Act (Chapter 317 of the 1999 Revised Edition), and to make consequential amendments to the Goods and Services Tax Act (Chapter 117A of the 2001 Revised Edition) and the Income Tax Act (Chapter 134 of the 2004 Revised Edition).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Statistics (Amendment) Act 2004 and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by notification in the *Gazette*, appoint.

Amendment of section 6

2. Section 6(5) of the Statistics Act is amended by deleting the words “relating to taxation or”.

Amendment of section 13

3. Section 13 of the Statistics Act is amended —

- (a) by deleting the words “subsection (2)” in subsection (1) and substituting the words “subsections (2) and (3)”; and
- (b) by inserting, immediately after subsection (2), the following subsection:

“(3) Without prejudice to subsection (2), the Minister may insert or delete and substitute in the second column of the Third Schedule any particulars or information obtained under any written law
