An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act (Chapter 276 of the 1985 Revised Edition).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Road Traffic (Amendment) Act 1991 and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by notification in the *Gazette*, appoint.

Amendment of section 10A

2. Section 10A(4) of the Road Traffic Act (referred to in this Act as the principal Act) is amended by inserting, immediately after paragraph (e), the following paragraph:

“(ea) provide for a rebate on all or any part of the levy payable for the issue of a permit under this section, in such circumstances as may be permitted by the rules;”.

Amendment of section 11

3. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by inserting, immediately after subsection (4), the following subsection:

“(4A) The Minister may prescribe a rebate on all or any part of the tax payable for vehicles of a specified class, category or description and the Minister may
