Statutes (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill

Bill No. 25/1994

Read the first time on 25th July 1994.

An Act to amend certain statutes of the Republic of Singapore.

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Statutes (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1994 and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by notification in the *Gazette*, appoint.

(2) The Minister may appoint different dates for the coming into operation of the different provisions of this Act.

Miscellaneous amendments

2. The provisions of the Acts specified in the first column of the Schedule are amended in the manner specified in the second column thereof.

(1) The Audit Act (Chapter 17)	
Section 9	(a) Delete the word “Every” in subsection (3) and substitute the words “Subject to subsection (3A), every”.
	(b) Insert, immediately after subsection (3), the following subsection: “(3A) Nothing in section 3 shall require the presentation to Parliament of any report or statement containing any matter which the Prime Minister and the Minister responsible for defence, on the recommendations of the Permanent Secretary to the Ministry of Defence and the Chief of Defence Force, certify to be necessary for the defence and security of Singapore, and any certificate under the hands of the Prime Minister and the Minister responsible for defence shall be conclusive evidence of the matters specified therein.”
