Central Sikh Gurdwara Board (Amendment) Bill

Read the first time on 9th December 1986.

An Act to amend the Central Sikh Gurdwara Board Act 1981 (No. 17 of 1981).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Central Sikh Gurdwara Board (Amendment) Act 1986 and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by notification in the *Gazette*, appoint.

Repeal and re-enactment of section 3

2. Section 3 of the Central Sikh Gurdwara Board Act 1981 (referred to in this Act as the principal Act) is repealed and the following section substituted therefor:

“Constitution of Board

3.—(1) The Board shall consist of such number of members who are elected at an annual general meeting by persons whose names appear on the Membership Register maintained by the Board under section 5.

(2) Every elected member of the Board shall hold office for a term of two years, but may continue in office until the election of his successor in office.

(3) No person shall be elected or appointed as a member of the Board unless he is a citizen of Singapore and his name is on the Membership Register maintained by the Board under section 5.

(4) Members of the Board shall be eligible for re-election or re-appointment.”.

Repeal and re-enactment of sections 5 and 6

3. Sections 5 and 6 of the principal Act are repealed and the following sections substituted therefor:

“Membership Register

5. The Board shall maintain a register (referred to in this Act as the Membership Register) containing the names and other particulars of persons who profess the
