An Act to provide for amendments, additions and omissions considered desirable by the Law Revision Commissioners in their preparation of a revised edition of Acts pursuant to the Revised Edition of the Laws Act 1983 (No. 9 of 1983).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Statute Law Revision (No. 2) Act 1986.

Amendments

2. The Acts specified in the First Schedule are amended in the manner set out in that Schedule.

Repeals

3. The Acts specified in the Second Schedule are repealed.

The Probate and Administration Act (Chapter 23)	Section 35(1): Delete the word “fifty” in the fourth line and substitute the words “two hundred and fifty”.
The Estate Duty Act (Chapter 137)	Section 10C: (a) Insert before subsection (1), the following subsection: “(1) Subject to this section, estate duty shall not be payable, in the case of a person dying on or after 1st April 1979 and before 1st April 1982, to the extent of — (a) the amount prescribed of the aggregate value of the deceased’s interest in a dwelling-house or dwelling-houses, whether occupied by the
