## **Statutes (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill**

#### **Bill No. 24/1986**

*Read the first time on 27th October 1986.*

An Act to amend certain Statutes of the Republic of Singapore.

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

#### **Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Statutes (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1986.

## Miscellaneous amendments

2. The provisions of the Acts specified in the first column of the Schedule are amended in the manner specified in the second column.

### THE SCHEDULE

(1) The Air Navigation Act  
(Chapter 87)

Insert, immediately after section 29, the following section:

#### **“Compounding of offences**

29A.—(1) The Minister or any officer authorised in that behalf by the Minister may, in his discretion, compound any offence under this Act or any subsidiary legislation made thereunder which is prescribed as a compoundable offence by collecting from a person reasonably suspected of having committed the offence a sum not exceeding \$200.

(2) The Minister may make rules to prescribe the offences which may be compounded.”.

(2) The Central Provident  
Fund Act (Chapter 121)

Insert, immediately after section 33, the following section:

#### **“Compounding of offences**

33A.—(1) The Board may, in its discretion, compound any offence under this Act or any regulations or rules made thereunder which is prescribed as a compoundable offence by collecting from a person reasonably suspected of having committed the offence a sum not exceeding \$200.

(2) The Board may make rules to prescribe the offences which may be compounded.”.

(3) The Merchant Shipping  
Act (Chapter 172)

Insert, immediately after section 421, the following section:

#### **“Compounding of offences**

421A. The Director may, in his discretion, compound any offence under this Act or any regulations made thereunder which is prescribed as a compoundable offence by collecting from a person reasonably suspected of having committed the offence a sum not exceeding \$200.”.

(4) The Public Utilities Act
