Bill No. 1/1981

Read the first time on 17th February 1981.

An Act to amend certain Statutes of the Republic of Singapore.

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows: —

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Statutes of the Republic of Singapore (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act, 1981.

Miscellaneous amendments

2. The provisions of the Acts specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Act are amended in the manner set out in the second column of the said Schedule.

The Institute of Education Act (Chapter 176).

Section 5(1)(e) and (f)

Delete and substitute the following paragraph: —

“(e) one member to be appointed by the Minister to represent the National University of Singapore;”.

The Dentists Registration Act (Chapter 215).

Sections 2(1)(b) and (e),
5(2) and 27(3)

Delete the words “University of Singapore” and substitute the words “National University of Singapore”.

Section 5(1)(a)

Delete and substitute the following paragraph: —

“(a) any person who holds a degree, diploma or licence in dentistry granted by the King Edward VII College of Medicine, Singapore, the University of Malaya in Singapore, the University of Singapore or the National University of Singapore;”.

The Legal Profession Act (Chapter 217).

Sections 2 (definition of
“Faculty”) and 36(1)(h)

Delete the words “University of Singapore” and substitute the words “National University of Singapore”.

Section 2 (paragraph (a) of
definition of “qualified
person”)

Delete and substitute the following paragraph: —

“(a) has passed the final examination for the degree of Bachelor of Laws in the University of Malaya in Singapore, the University of Singapore or the National University of Singapore; or”.

Section 9(1) (proviso)

Delete the words “University of Singapore or in the University of Malaya” and substitute the words “National University of Singapore”.
