AIR NAVIGATION ACT (CHAPTER 6)

AIR NAVIGATION (91 — GENERAL OPERATING RULES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3A of the Air Navigation Act, the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore, with the approval of the Minister for Transport, makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Air Navigation (91 — General Operating Rules) (Amendment) Regulations 2021 and come into operation on 4 November 2021.

New regulation 48A

2. The Air Navigation (91 — General Operating Rules) Regulations 2018 (G.N. No. S 441/2018) are amended by inserting, immediately after regulation 48, the following regulation:

"Reporting of unsatisfactory runway braking action

48A.—(1) The pilot-in-command of an aeroplane operated by a holder of an air operator certificate granted under the Air Navigation (119 — Air Operator Certification) Regulations 2018 must, as soon as possible after encountering an unsatisfactory runway braking action while landing the aircraft at an aerodrome, make a report to the air traffic control unit at that aerodrome.

(2) The report made under paragraph (1) must —

(*a*) be made in the form and manner that the Director-General of Civil Aviation requires; and
