COVID-19 (TEMPORARY MEASURES)  
(MAJOR BUSINESS EVENTS — CONTROL ORDER)  
(AMENDMENT NO. 5) REGULATIONS 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34(1) of the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) Act 2020, the Minister for Health makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations are the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Major Business Events — Control Order) (Amendment No. 5) Regulations 2021 and come into operation on 10 August 2021.

**Amendment of regulation 5**

2. Regulation 5 of the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Major Business Events — Control Order) Regulations 2021 (G.N. No. S 278/2021) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations) is amended by deleting “100” in paragraph (a) and substituting “250”.

**Amendment of regulation 8**

3. Regulation 8 of the principal Regulations is amended —
- (a) by deleting the words “whom the venue manager of the venue knows or has reason to believe” in paragraph (1)(b);
  - (b) by inserting, immediately before the word “is” in paragraph (1)(b)(i) and (ii), the words “whom the venue manager of the venue knows or has reason to believe”; and
  - (c) by deleting paragraph (2) and substituting the following paragraphs:
