PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION
(DO NOT CALL REGISTRY) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 65 of the Personal Data Protection Act 2012, the Personal Data Protection Commission, with the approval of the Minister for Communications and Information, makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Personal Data Protection (Do Not Call Registry) (Amendment) Regulations 2021 and come into operation on 1 February 2021.

Deletion of regulation 11

2. Regulation 11 of the Personal Data Protection (Do Not Call Registry) Regulations 2013 (G.N. No. S 709/2013) is deleted.

Deletion and substitution of Part V and new Part VA

3. Part V of the Personal Data Protection (Do Not Call Registry) Regulations 2013 is deleted and the following Parts substituted therefor:

“PART V

PRESCRIBED DURATION AND PERIOD

Prescribed duration for section 43(2)(a) of Act

15. For the purposes of section 43(2)(a) of the Act, the prescribed duration before sending a specified message on or after 1 February 2021 is 21 days.
