### **ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 276)**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) RULES 2021**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 140 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Rules:

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Rules are the Road Traffic (Amendment) Rules 2021 and come into operation on 3 January 2022.

#### **Amendment of rule 1A**

**2.** Rule 1A of the Road Traffic Rules (R 20) is amended by inserting, immediately before the definition of “Bus Give-Way Box”, the following definitions:

““ambulance” means a motor vehicle that is specifically equipped for —

(a) the transport on roads of; and

(b) the provision, during such transport, of out-of-hospital clinical care to,

sick or injured individuals who require emergency medical treatment;

“authorised”, for an ambulance, means —

(a) being specified in a licence (other than a revoked licence) under the Healthcare Services Act 2020 authorising the use of the ambulance to provide a licensable healthcare service specified in that licence; or
