ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 276)

ROAD TRAFFIC (BICYCLES) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) RULES 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 140 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (Bicycles) (Amendment No. 2) Rules 2021 and come into operation on 1 January 2022.

New rule 7A

2. The Road Traffic (Bicycles) Rules (R 3) are amended by inserting, immediately after rule 7, the following rule:

“Cycling groups

7A.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), a person must not ride a bicycle, power-assisted bicycle or tricycle on a road in a cycling group that consists of more than 5 bicycles, power-assisted bicycles or tricycles (or any combination of them).

(2) Without affecting rule 7, a person may ride a bicycle, power-assisted bicycle or tricycle on a road in a cycling group that consists of more than 5 but not more than 10 bicycles, power-assisted bicycles or tricycles (or any combination of them) if —

- (a) the road has 2 or more lanes for the use of vehicles travelling in the same direction;
- (b) the person does not ride in a bus lane during the hours of operation of the bus lane; and
