In exercise of the powers conferred by section 66 of the Active Mobility Act 2017, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

Citation and period in force

- **1.**—(1) This Order is the Active Mobility (Specified Forklifts Exemption) Order 2020.
- (2) This Order is in force for the period starting at 11 p.m. on 7 August 2020 and ending at 6 a.m. on 8 August 2020.

Definitions

2. In this Order —

"Jalan Besar Town Council" means the Town Council for the Town of Jalan Besar:

- "specified activity" means the carrying out of replacement and maintenance works on 2 escalators at Block 32 New Market Road;
- "specified footpath" means the part of the footpath delineated by the black-coloured line in the map set out in the Schedule;
- "specified vehicle" means a forklift bearing any of the following vehicle identification numbers:
 - (a) 62-8FD25;
 - (b) 62-8FD30;
 - (c) 8FD40N.

Exemption for driver of specified vehicle

- **3.** Section 16(1)(b) of the Act does not apply to an individual driving a specified vehicle on the specified footpath under the following conditions:
 - (a) the individual is authorised by the Jalan Besar Town Council to drive the specified vehicle;
 - (b) the individual has completed and passed a forklift operation course conducted by a forklift training provider that is accredited by the SkillsFuture Singapore Agency to provide the course;
 - (c) the specified vehicle is driven only in connection with the specified activity;
 - (d) the individual possesses a valid Class 3, 3A, 3C or 3CA driving licence granted under the Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Driving Licences) Rules (Cap. 276, R 27);
