**ARMS AND EXPLOSIVES ACT  
(CHAPTER 13)**

**ARMS AND EXPLOSIVES  
(MOVEMENT CONTROL)  
(AMENDMENT) RULES 2020**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 46 of the Arms and Explosives Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Rules:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Rules are the Arms and Explosives (Movement Control) (Amendment) Rules 2020 and come into operation on 21 September 2020.

**Amendment of rule 6**

**2.** Rule 6 of the Arms and Explosives (Movement Control) Rules (R 4) (called in these Rules the principal Rules) is amended —

- (a) by deleting the words “shall be made in the Form A set out in the Schedule” in paragraph (1) and substituting the words “must be made in accordance with rule 6A”;
- (b) by deleting the words “shall be in the Form B set out in the Schedule and shall be subject to the conditions set out therein and such other” in paragraph (1) and substituting the words “is subject to such”; and
- (c) by deleting paragraphs (3) and (4) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(3) This rule does not apply to or in relation to the removal of —

- (a) any arms by a person to whom a licence to possess those arms is issued under the
