BANKRUPTCY (COSTS) (REVOCATION) RULES 2020

ARRANGEMENT OF RULES

Rule

- 1. Citation and commencement
- 2. Revocation
- 3. Saving and transitional provision

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 166 of the Bankruptcy Act, the Minister for Law makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Bankruptcy (Costs) (Revocation) Rules 2020 and come into operation on 30 July 2020.

Revocation

2. The Bankruptcy (Costs) Rules (R 2) are revoked.

Saving and transitional provision

- **3.** Despite rule 2, the Bankruptcy (Costs) Rules as in force immediately before 30 July 2020 continue to apply to or in relation to the following:
 - (a) any application for an interim order made under section 45 of the Act before that date;
 - (b) any bankruptcy application made before that date and any bankruptcy arising from such an application;
 - (c) any application for an order for the administration in bankruptcy of a deceased debtor's estate under section 148
